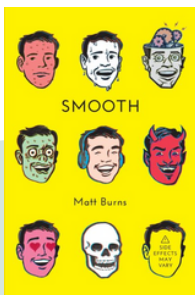
### **A Complicated Love Story Set in Space** by Shaun David Hutchinson

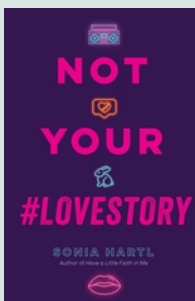
### **Rent a Boyfriend** by Gloria Chao

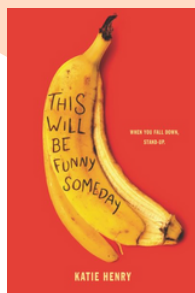
### **Again Again** by E. Lockhart

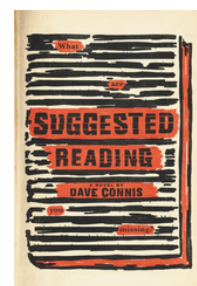

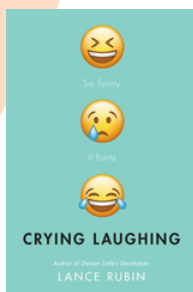
