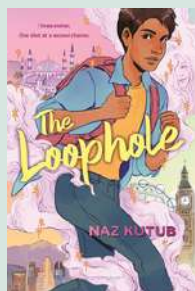

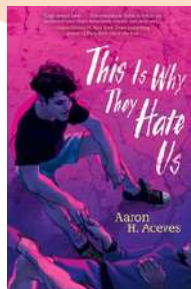
Baby teeth by Meg Grehan

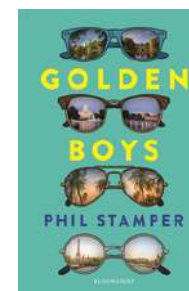
