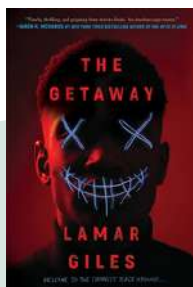
Second death of Edie and Violet Bond by Amanda Glaze
