

WIRELESS ACCESS POLICY

Wireless use agreement

The Alhambra Civic Center Library provides free filtered* wireless access to the Internet. Wireless users must agree to abide by the Library's Behavior Policy and the Library's Computer and Internet Use Policy. Wireless users who do not follow the rules for wireless Internet access may be asked to stop using the wireless connection at the library, may lose wireless or library privileges and/or be prosecuted.

Due to the proliferation of wireless networks, library users may also be able to access other wireless networks within the library that are not provided by the library. Use of non-library networks within the library is also governed by the Library's Internet Policy and Behavior Policy.

Wireless availability

Wireless access is available when the Library is open.

Connecting to the wireless network

You will need to provide your own laptop computer or other wireless device. Staff will not assist you in accessing the wireless network on your computer device nor will they be able to do any troubleshooting. You are responsible for understanding how to configure your own equipment. The library cannot guarantee your equipment will work with the library's network.

Wireless network security

Communication over a wireless network is not secure. The Alhambra Civic Center Library assumes no responsibility for the safety of your equipment or data while using the Library's wireless network.

The Library recommends that all laptops and other wireless devices have up-to-date anti-virus software, spyware protection, and a personal firewall installed while using a wireless network.

Personal equipment security

Do not leave your personal equipment unattended. The library is not responsible for equipment that is lost, damaged, or stolen.

Using power outlets

Available power outlets may be used wherever the cord does not present a tripping hazard or block access for patrons or staff. Chairs or tables are not to be moved to electrical outlets. It is recommended that you charge your device's battery before coming to the library.

Audio

Please access Internet and other applications with sound using your own headphones.

Bandwidth

The library reserves the right to limit bandwidth on a per laptop or computer connection basis on the wireless network. This will ensure network reliability and fair sharing of network resources for all computer users.
